

Planning Application 0517/21

5th October, 2021

Minutes of the Planning Committee who met on Tuesday 19th October, 2021 at 7:15pm in the Village Hall.

Present: Councillors Edmundson, Moorhead, Huda, Farrar, Glinn and Roche (Chairman)

0517/21 'Change of use of land for the keeping of horses and associated works including the siting of two mobile buildings and creation of access track (retrospective)' at Sky Star Paddock, Jordan Lane, Horrabridge.

Cllr Roche explained that the Council had supported the applicant's original application in 2018 to site the two buildings as permanent structures in a more prominent position in the field. DNPA Planners referred the application to the full committee, who refused. The applicant appealed to the Secretary of State whose Inspector supported the refusal.

The new application was for buildings which were capable of being moved (timber runners underneath) and to the side of the field in a less prominent position.

DNPA policies do not favour random stable and associated buildings, which is why the original application was refused. DNPA may well again refuse.

The Planning Sub-Committee unanimously resolved to **Support** the application.

DNPA have been informed of the decision.
